Why does the City sweep our streets?

- Helps City comply with San Bernardino County MS4
 NPDES permit (storm water discharge permit)
- Removes trash and debris from curb

 Sweeping is identified as a best management practices in its NPDES Permit



Street Sweeping City of Grand Terrace

Environmental Benefits Per Mile Swept

- 10 pounds of oil and grease removed
- 3 pounds of Nitrogen and Phosphorus removed

 Reduces contaminate amounts from seeping into ground water.









Why am I ticketed for not moving my car?

For every 1 car obstructing the sweeper
 3 parking spaces are not swept.

 More area swept reduces the contaminates flowing to the storm drains.

Remember your week for street sweeping.



Parking is restricted on the street from <u>6:00 am to</u> <u>3:00 pm.</u>

You are subject to a ticket if you park on the street before 3:00 p.m.

The sweeper might return for quality purposes and if your car is parked on the street <u>before 3:00 pm,</u> you may be ticketed.
